DATA PROTECTION NOTICE

With the present notice, **IA Agriculture Hungary Kft.** (registered seat: 1085 Budapest, Kálvin tér 12-13.; registry number: 01-09-372728; hereinafter: "**Data Controller**") hereunder provides detailed information about the data processing activity related to its website.

The present notice provides detailed information about the Data Controller's data processing activity, including the legal basis, the purpose, the expected duration of data processing, the involved data processor(s) (if any), the data subjects' rights and the means available to exercise these rights during the data processing period.

The main purpose of the Data Controller is to comply with the related legislation in the course of its data processing activity, accordingly, in case of any change in the relevant legislation, or in each data processing activity, or in the data protection practices, the present notice shall be amended. Accordingly, the Data Controller reserves the right to modify, amend or revoke this notice with the provision that the amended version of the present notice shall be communicated in the identical way as the original one with those who concerned.

1. Legal background, definitions

1.1 With the present notification the Data Controller is intended to comply with the following Hungarian and EU legislation:

- (i) Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data ("**GDPR**");
- (ii) Act CXII of 2011 on the Right of Informational Self-Determination and on Freedom of Information.

1.2 Definitions in the present notice:

The definitions (capitalized terms) used in the present notice corresponds to those used in the GDPR.

2. Details of the data processing activity

Data Controller: IA Agriculture Hungary Kft.

Data protection officer: data protection officer has not been appointed.

The purpose(s) of the data processing: Replying to the questions and/or the inquiries addressed to the representative of the Data Controller, providing information, contact.

The basis of the processing: consent of the data subject [GDPR Article 6(1)(a)].

The types of the processed personal data: the data subject's (i) name, (ii) e-mail address, (iii) availability/ies, (iv) details of the inquiry and any additional personal data provided by the data subject in the course of his/her inquiry, (v) data related to the response to the inquiry.

The period of the processing: until the withdrawal of the consent, otherwise during the contact and until that the processing purpose is achieved, but – following the termination of the contact - for a maximum period of 6 month.

Data processor(s), other recipient(s): disclosure of your personal data is only allowed to persons who need to know your personal information for the fulfilment of the above purposes.

The Data Controller's data processor in respect of the present processing activity is Site Street (registered seat: ●; Reg. No.: ●), which provides hosting services. Otherwise the data are not transferred to any third party and/ or organization, unless required to do so by the competent authority, court. ●

Automated decision-making: Data Controller does not apply automated decision-making in the course of its data processing activity, including profiling.

Failure to provide information: providing information is not mandatory, however, if the data subject refuses to provide the necessary data, or does not contact the Data Controller, the Data Controller would not be in the position to reply his/her questions, inquiries (properly).

4. Data protection measures

4.1 The Data Controller, in accordance with the GDPR, has implemented appropriate technical and organizational protection measures in order to guarantee the level of data-security appropriate to the degree of risk.

4.2 Accordingly, the Data Controller operates IT systems which ensure the prevention of unauthorized access to personal data and grant that personal data would be available to those who have a right of access, and prevent from any unlawful alteration, accidental or unlawful destruction, any damage and any event which may render inaccessible. The data processor(s) and the employees of the Data Controller shall comply with the abovementioned obligations as well.

4.3 The IT systems of the Data Controller apply the following information technology solutions to ensure the security of the personal data:

- the Data Controller has secure servers;
- the Data Controller provide appropriate IT, technical and personnel measures.

5. Personal data breaches

In the case of a personal data breach, the controller shall without undue delay and, where feasible, not later than 72 hours after having become aware of it, notify the competent supervisory authority (in Hungary: "*Nemzeti Adatvédelmi és Információszabadság Hatóság*", Hungarian National Authority for Data Protection and Freedom of Information) about the personal data breach, unless the personal data breach is unlikely to result in a risk to the rights and freedoms of natural persons.

6. Rights relating to the data processing through the website

In accordance with the GDPR, data subjects, as a contact person, may have the following rights:

- (a) **Access to personal data:** right to request and obtain information about the processing of his/her personal data and may request a copy of such Personal Data.
- (b) **Rectification of Personal Data:** has the right to request the rectification or supplementation of his/her personal data, if the data subject considers his/her personal data to be inaccurate or incomplete.
- (c) **Erasure of Personal Data:** has the right to request the erasure of his/her personal data within the limitations permitted by law.
- (d) **Requesting the restriction of the processing of personal data:** has the right to request the restriction of the processing of his/her data within the limitations specified by the law.
- (e) **Withdrawal of consent:** has the right to withdraw his/her consent to the processing of his/her personal data previously provided to the data controller. The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent that was carried out before its withdrawal.
- (f) **Right to data portability:** Within the limitations permitted by the law, data subject has the right to receive the personal data he/she provided to the Data Controller in accordance with the law, and he/she is also entitled to request such personal data to be transferred to another controller. In exercising your right to data portability, he/she is also entitled to have your personal data transmitted directly from one controller to another, where technically feasible.
- (g) **Right not to be subject to automated data processing:** to the extent permitted by law data subject has the right not to be subject to decision-making based only on automated data processing (including profiling), which would have legal effects on him/her or would similarly affect him/her to a significant extent.

Data subject has the right to object to the processing of his/her personal data at any time based on his/her individual circumstances if data processing is based on the enforcement of the legitimate interests of the Data Controller or third parties (including profiling and based on it).

In this case, Data Controller may no longer process personal data unless the Data Controller demonstrates compelling legitimate grounds for processing which override his/her interests, rights and freedoms or for the establishment, exercise or defense of legal claims.

Where personal data are processed for direct marketing purposes, data subject shall have the right to object at any time to processing of personal data relating to you for such marketing, which includes profiling to the extent that it is related to such direct marketing. In such a case, the personal data may no longer be processed for such purposes.

To protect the data subject's data and prevent unauthorized access to his/her personal data, Data Controller may request him/her to provide additional personal identification data.

Pursuant to the provisions of the GDPR, and in addition to the data subject's specific rights relating to the data subject's personal data, referred to above, he/she has the right to lodge a complaint to a supervisory authority, in particular in the EU Member State of his/her habitual residence or workplace, or where the suspected breach of your personal data occurred, in accordance with data protection laws in force.

As data subject has the right to lodge a complaint to the supervisory authority, Data Controller hereby provide information about the supervisory authority in Hungary:

If, in the data subject's opinion, his/her personal data were processed in non-compliance with the requirements of the GDPR, and therefore his/her rights under the GDPR were infringed, he/she has the right to take legal steps before the competent court. He/she may institute proceedings against the Data Controller before the court of the Member State in which the Data Controller pursues its activity, or – at the data subject's discretion – before the court based on the data subject's habitual residence.
